The NARTP is catalyzing innovation with an ecosystem of partnerships and harnessing the power of collaboration, facilitating research and development, innovation, and commercialization of emerging aerospace technologies. And it's all happening right here, in southern New Jersey!



As New Jersey's only designated "Aviation District," leasing at NARTP offers tax credit incentives to companies that create jobs in the state.

The park is located on a 58-acre parcel adjoining the Federal Aviation Administration William J. Hughes Technical Center (WJHTC), an internationally recognized facility dedicated to research, development, and sustainment of the National Airspace System, and the Atlantic City International Airport (ACY), a designated Smart Airport Research Test Bed Facility. At full build out, the NARTP will consist of seven multi-story buildings comprising 400,000 SF of state-of-the-art research and development facilities.

NARTP's Building #2 offers tenants advanced aerospace research facilities and high-speed connectivity to the WJHTC. Tenants in Building #2 will also have access to the extraordinary features in Building #1, including the famous Thunder Room multimedia auditorium.

THE EMERGING LEADER IN UAS/AAM

The NARTP is receiving increasing interest from Unmanned Aerial Systems/Advanced Air Mobility (UAS/AAM) related companies. The FAA recently signed a multi-year agreement with NASA to use space at the NARTP for advanced air mobility projects. Research related to this facet of aviation focuses on the safety implications of nascent UAS operational concepts, their testing and certification, as well as the emerging technologies that will be needed to support the development of new regulatory standards.

There is a growing focus on UAS research areas such as detection and avoidance, datalink control, air traffic control communications, and emergency response requirements. Safety-related research areas include advanced materials, airworthiness, and cyber security.
